An increased entry of 3430 lambs forward meeting a much sharper trade on the week, with all weights seeing spirited bidding and strong demand. The overall average returned at 355ppkg.

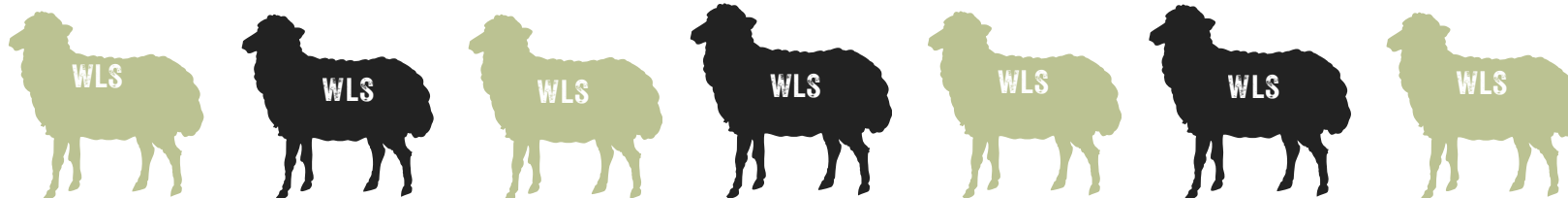
Export and Supermarket spec hogs mainly trading between 345ppkg and 365ppkg. Best hogs trading 370ppkg to 390ppkg. Heavy weight hogs very much in demand this week with 50kg to 54kg lambs trading anywhere between £155 – £175. Lightweight hogg also sharper on the week and mainly trading anywhere between 320ppkg and 340ppkg depending on breed and meat cover. Good number of prime hogs will be required next week please! Due to increasing pressure from Abattoirs and the Meat Hygiene Service, it is now strongly advisable that in order to market your sheep to their maximum potential that all hogs big or small and whether from inside or outside be BELLY CLIPPED before arrival at market.

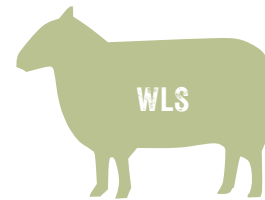
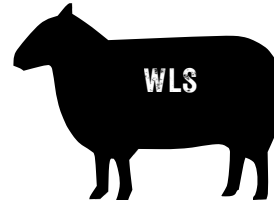
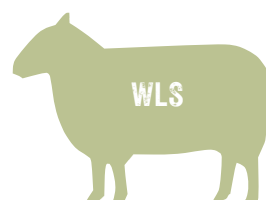
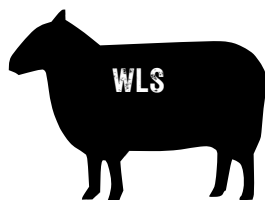
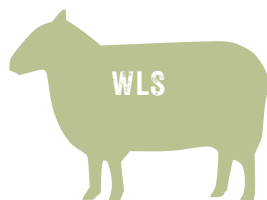
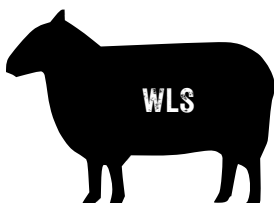
Excellent numbers forward again this week with a total of 2,340 cull ewes forward selling to another fast and strong trade. The overall average returned at a pleasing £128.48 per head. Today's entry would lack the strength of last week's show with numerous smaller barren ewes forward however seeing plenty of spirited bidding. All crossbred ewes from £150 - £200 per head with anything very well-bred or heavy all over the £200 mark. Best Mules £140 - £165 per head with mediums Mules with meat mainly £120 - £135 per head. Leaner Mules anywhere from £95 - £115 per head. Strong hill ewes £120 - £140 per head depending on size and cover, with medium Welsh all around that £85 - £115 per head and the smaller meated Welsh £45 - £75, with very few ewes below £40 per head.

The ewes topped at £312 for a heavy ewe presented by G I Francis & Co, The Bryn. Cull ram trade similar to last week's trade with very few best rams forward however rams' selling to highs of £248 for a Texel ram presented by JM Rowlands, Dolwen. Numerous crossbred rams £140 to £180 with hill rams anything from £90 to £140.

Ewe lambs average £81.76 and to £127 from S Lane, Penygelli.

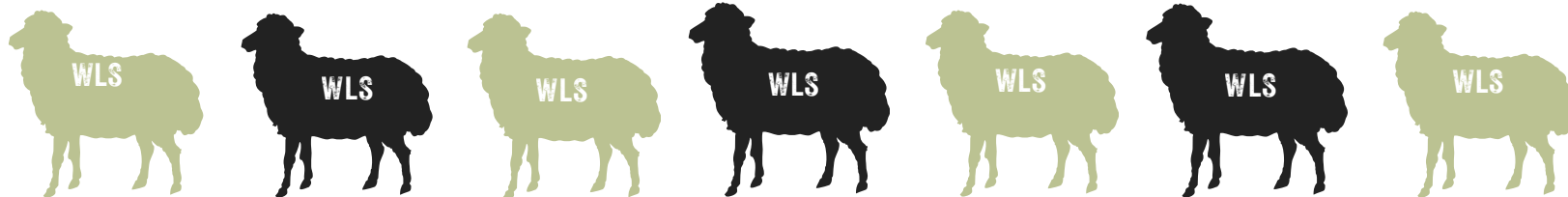
Mixed and clean lambs average £102.14 and to £149 from JH & ML Breeze, Moelygarth.

DT & CE Jones sells 60 Texel and Mule flock aged ewes in lamb to Texel rams at 152% to £220 and averages £183.

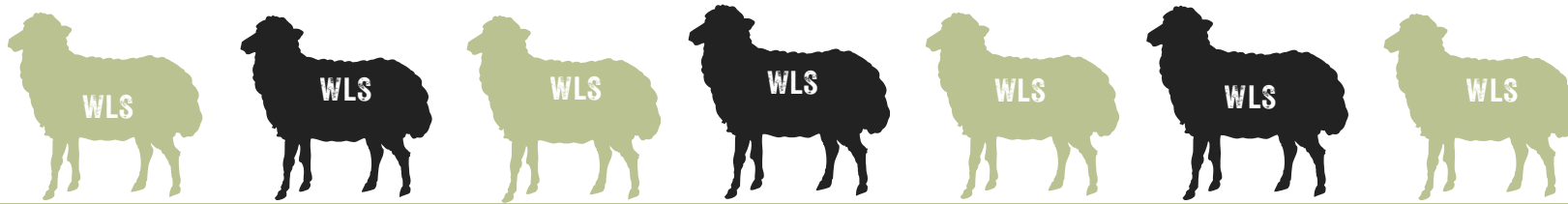
