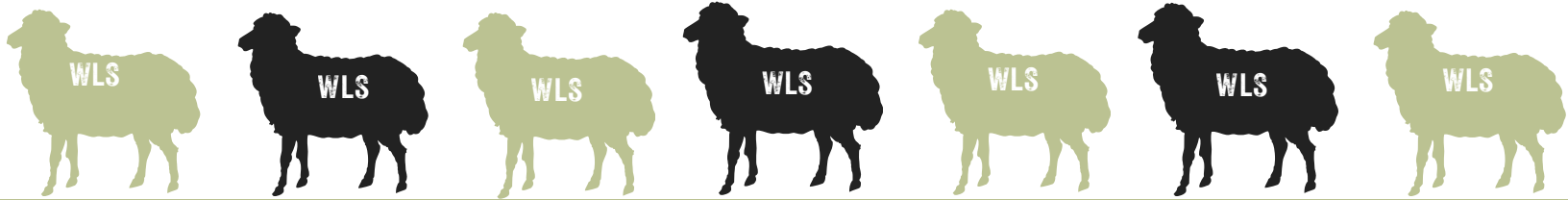

Prime lambs between 36kg and 42kg seeing the most noticeable demand. A noticeable premium also for tup lambs today, so please pick these out separate again next week as firms will be looking to source tup lambs for the upcoming Qurbani festival next week. More spring lambs are now required on a weekly basis to meet buyers' demand.

Another pleasing entry of 4306 hogs forward meeting a very lively and strong trade on the week, with all weights seeing spirited bidding and strong demand. The overall average returned at impressive 427ppkg. Export and Supermarket spec hogs mainly trading between 420ppkg and 430ppkg. Best hogs trading 440ppkg to 460ppkg. Heavy weight hogs very much in demand this week with 50kg to 60kg lambs trading anywhere between £195 - £250. Lightweight hogg also similar on the week and mainly trading anywhere between 375ppkg and 400ppkg depending on breed and meat cover. Good number of prime hogs will be required again next week please! Due to increasing pressure from Abattoirs and the Meat Hygiene Service, it is now strongly advisable that in order to market your sheep to their maximum potential that all hogs big or small and whether from inside or outside be BELLY CLIPPED before arrival at market

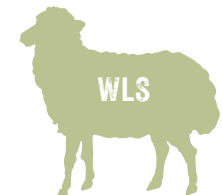
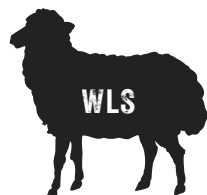

Selling for 289ppkg was a Limousin x cow weighing 678kg making £1959.42 from FJ Owens & Co, Llettygynfach.

Heifers under 48 months sold to £2339.26 for a Charolais heifer weighing 682kg selling for 343ppkg from Roberts & Jones, Parc. Also selling for 343ppkg was another Charolais heifer from the same home, this time weighing 573kg making £1965.39.

Bulls sold to £3031.50 for a Charolais bull weighing 1075kg selling for 282ppkg from CF Jones, Lower Cefnpenarth. Selling for 404ppkg was a Limousin x bull weighing 653kg making £2638.12 from RC Gethin & Son, Tanllan.

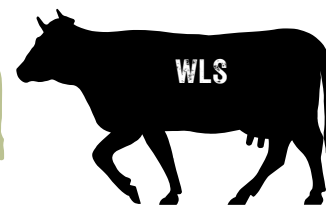
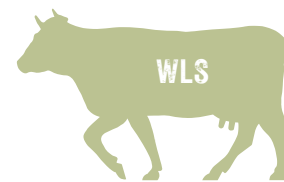
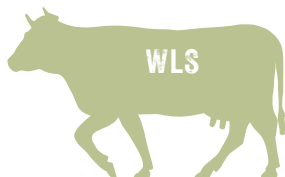
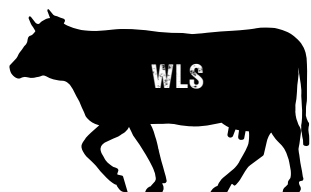

Good numbers forward again this week with a total of 4,854 cull ewes forward selling to another consistent and strong trade although back on the week. The overall average returned at a very satisfying £147.66 per head. Similar show of mixed ewes forward to previous weeks with numerous hill ewes and half meat ewes present yet seeing plenty of demand for them. All crossbred ewes from £150 - £200 per head with quite a few very well-bred ewes and heavy ewes all over the £210 mark. Best Mules £165 - £195 per head with mediums Mules with meat mainly £140 - £160 per head. Leaner Mules anywhere from £110 - £130 per head. Strong Cheviots ewes £150 - £175 per head, strong hill ewes anywhere from £130 - £170 per head depending on size and cover, with medium Welsh all around that £100 - £125 per head and the smaller meated Welsh £55 - £90, with very few ewes below £40 per head. The ewes topped at £280 for some very well-bred Texel ewes presented by Red House Farm. Cull ram trade similar to last week's trade with rams selling to the highs of £265 for rams presented by DA & MD Wright & Son, Heathmynd.

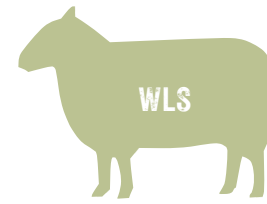
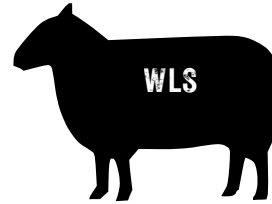
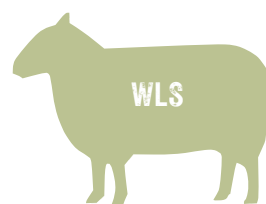
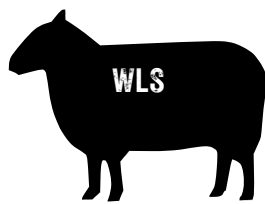
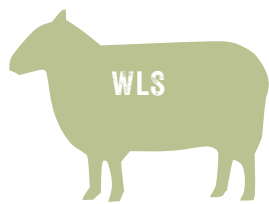
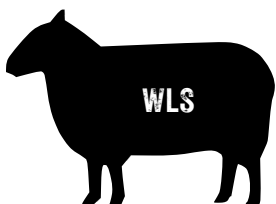
Numerous crossbred rams £160 to £220 with hill rams anything from £100 to £140.

An entry of 20 Cows & Calves met a tremendous trade with every outfit forward today averaging £3780.

Leading the way at £4400 was a Limousin x 1st calver with a April born Limousin bull calf from S Evans, Cae Gwyn. From the same home was a Limousin x 1st calver with a heifer calf which sold for £3950. Two British Blue x 1st calvers with Limousin x heifer calves at foot sold at £3750 and £3550. Overall 7 outfits from S Evans averaged £3700.

The first consignment of the year from Guto Davies, Hafodlas resulted in a cracking average of £4014 for the first 10 sold at Welshpool this year.

Topping Guto's trade twice at £4300 were a Limousin x 1st calver with a heifer calf and a Aberdeen Angus x 1st calver with a bull calf with other Limousin x 1st calvers with a Limousin x bull calf for £2750.
